### **Jennifer Hunter:**

- Photo Contest for the 2023 Historic Preservation Calendar deadline extended to Friday 7/15/22.
- HPB is reviewing floor area ratio which is currently at .5. There is a potential to change it to .4.

### **Commissioner Patty Sheehan:**

- Redistricting changes added some Conway Area but mainly remain the same due to even growth. All historic districts except downtown district remain in district 4.
- Gas tax revenue declining and is providing less money to repair roads. City needs funding from transportation tax. Revenue also will provide regional system for light timing and brick street repair.

### **Officer Eddie Rosado:**

- Stats for June 2022
  - 135 calls for service / June 2021 had 132 calls for service
  - 22 incidents / December 2021 had 16 incidents
  - 18 suspicious person calls / December 2021 had 11 suspicious person calls
